

## WHY ACFC WEST, LOCAL 2020 UNIFOR?

*When you become a member of ACFC West, Local 2020 Unifor, you will belong to and have the support of a Canadian based union that is a member of the Canadian Labour Congress (CLC).*

*As you spend more time on the ACFC West, Local 2020 Unifor productions, you will have the opportunity to meet and work with a valuable network of film craftspeople.*

*We are focused on creating the best working conditions for our membership. Your crew will have elected a crew representative to assist you with your questions. Your Union Representative from the ACFC West, Local 2020 Unifor will be on set regularly to answer any questions that may arise.*

## APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Department application
- Résumé
- Motion Picture Industry Orientation (MPIO) course  
(can include WHMIS and Set Etiquette)
- OR
- Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) Certificate, and
- MPIO course  
Please provide a photocopy of certificate(s).
- \$85 Administration fee\*
- Additional \$25 if applying for a 2nd department
- Signed Bargaining Authorization - original signature required
- Minimum 30 verifiable days worked on professional made-for-television productions or feature films **in the position you are applying for.**

\* The \$85 fee is an administration fee to process your application. This is not a guarantee that you will be accepted as a member. Should your application not be complete, or should you not meet the required minimum standards, your application will be held until all minimum requirements are met and you will be able to request re-application in the same department at a later date without charges.

## WHO ARE WE?

ACFC West, Local 2020 Unifor is a technical film union recognized by the Labour Board of British Columbia. The union began as an association of freelance film technicians who were unified in their need for protection and endorsement while working in the film industry. Policies of the union are developed by the Council\* and ratified by the members according to their constitution.

ACFC West, Local 2020 Unifor represents technicians in the following departments:

Some of the highlights of the union are:

- non-seniority crewing;
- producers and department keys hire their choice of technicians depending on the dynamics of each production team;
- full members and permittees are hired based on their skills and ability rather than their position on a seniority list. This style of crewing is attractive for qualified technicians who would like to achieve a higher position and pay rates.

\* Council consists of the Executive (President, Vice-President, Secretary/Treasurer, Members at Large) and the Department Representatives, who are members working on film and television productions.

## HOW DO I APPLY FOR MEMBERSHIP (PERMITTEE STATUS)?

Once you decide which department(s) you would like to apply for, complete the appropriate departmental application form and send it to the ACFC West office\*\*. Completed applications are submitted to the Council at any Council meeting (about 10 times per year).

Once you have been approved, your membership status will be that of **PERMITTEE**.

Permittees' names and contact numbers are included on availability lists sent from the union office to ACFC West signatory productions for the position requested by a production. You should promote yourself to ACFC West productions by emailing or dropping off your résumé to the production offices.

## HOW DO I APPLY FOR FULL MEMBER STATUS?

If you are currently a permittee or an applicant and have a minimum 90 days on set work on ACFC West, Local 2020 Unifor production(s) in an ACFC West position, you can apply for full member status with the following criteria:

- ✓ 3 letters or signatures of endorsement from:
  - a) a key in your department who is a member in good standing;
  - b) two other members in good standing;an endorsement form is available from the ACFC West, Local 2020 Unifor office.
- ✓ an updated résumé accurately reflecting your days worked.

Advantages to becoming a full member:

- lower check-off dues;
- access to health benefits;
- access to educational reimbursements;
- the right to participate in and vote on union affairs.

Applications to full member status are reviewed by the Council at any council meeting (about 10 times per year). Applicants will be notified in writing upon acceptance.

Note: full members are required to pay initiation dues and annual membership dues. Please contact the office for the current rates.

## HOW DO I APPLY FOR A POSITION UPGRADE?

After working on ACFC West, Local 2020 Unifor productions for a while, you may want to upgrade your position with the union so that your résumé can be sent out for a higher position in the department you are recognized in.

To qualify, you must meet all of the following:

- ✓ have full member status;
- ✓ have a minimum of 3 credits (2 of which must be on union productions, with at least 1 ACFC West credit), or 90 days on an ACFC West series in the upgraded position;
- ✓ submit an updated résumé outlining your credits and days worked, and a verification of your position and days worked (i.e., time sheets, paystubs, etc.).

If you are upgrading to a key position, you may be required to take the ACFC West Supervisor's Course.

When you have met all the above criteria, your position may be upgraded with the union.
