

# EDUCATION & TRAINING

The following are approved courses eligible for reimbursement through ACFC West, Local 2020 UNIFOR's Education and Training program.

ACFC West, Local 2020 UNIFOR will reimburse full Members in Good Standing 75% of the cost, up to a maximum of \$1,350 per calendar year, upon the successful completion of approved courses listed here.

Total reimbursement shall never exceed 100% of the cost of the successfully completed course.

Members may be reimbursed for any of the courses listed, regardless of whether or not it is in their department.

## REIMBURSEMENT GUIDELINES

- 2) Submit proof of completion of course (certificate, diploma, statement of grades, letter from instructor).
